In any meeting concerning The Scarlets these days there is no getting away from the main issue i.e. the granting of planning permission for the proposed housing development at Stradey. HMJ fully acknowledged that the “not knowing one way or the other” was of no benefit at all, to neither the Stradey residents, the rugby club nor its supporters.

Due to no overall party getting a clear majority at the recent Assembly elections there currently exists no First Minister and consequently no Cabinet. Until this is decided, no-one can be appointed minister for the Environment, Planning and The Countryside. It is highly unlikely that Carwyn Jones will be re-appointed to this position.

HMJ stated that when the new minister is in place he / she will probably take the recommendations contained in the report and endorse those contents. She did state though that there had been instances in the past where ministers had disagreed / changed etc aspects of recommendations from other reports but felt that this was unlikely in this situation.

We were given assurances by HMJ that she will seek a quick decision from the relevant minister as soon he / she is appointed and will keep us informed of any developments. Due to delay in appointing ministers it would probably be the 2<sup>nd</sup> week in June at the earliest that a decision will be made.
